

Lakewood Country Club Swimming Pool Rules

- 1. Members of Lakewood Country Club, their dependants, and their eligible guests are authorized to use the pool facilities. All members must fill out a family information form that will be provided by the lifeguards.**
- 2. All members must report to the lifeguard to register when they arrive. The member is responsible for guest fees being paid. Violations will result in the suspension of the pool privileges. Fees are as follows:**

In Town Guest (Living within 50 miles of Lakewood Country Club) Fee is \$5.00 per person. All guests are limited to 5 visits per year! Lakewood Country Club reserves the right to determine the qualifications of the guest.

- 3. The pool manager or designated lifeguards are in full charge of the swimming pool area. The lifeguard's decision will be FINAL in matters of safety and discipline. Any complaints may be directed to the Club Manager.**

FIRST OFFENSE	30 MINUTE SIT OUT
SECOND OFFENSE	1 WEEK SUSPENSION
THIRD OFFENSE	2 WEEKS SUSPENSION
FOURTH OFFENSE	1 YEAR SUSPENSION

- 4. All persons using pool do so at their own risk.**
- 5. Proper attire is required in the golf shop. After purchasing snacks from the Pro Shop, please return back to the pool.**
- 6. Members are responsible for all damage done by themselves or their guest.**
- 7. The Pool is closed when weather is deemed unsuitable. RED CROSS RULE: If there is thunder, both pools will be cleared for 15 minutes from the last time it thundered. If there is lightning, both pools will be cleared for 30 minutes after the last lightning is seen.**
- 8. Everyone must shower before entering the pool.**
- 9. No chewing gum.**

10. The pool and wading pool will be cleared for 15 minute every hour for resting purposes. (Adults over 21 years of age are exempted).
11. An adult must be present inside the wading pool with each child at all times.
12. A person with a fever, cold, inflamed eyes, skin disease, or bandages will not be permitted to use the pool.
13. **BEFORE A CHILD MAY BE LEFT ALONE AT THE POOL HE/SHE IS REQUIRED TO PASS A SWIMMING TEST FOR THE LIFEGUARDS. NO CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 8 CAN BE LEFT ALONE WITHOUT AN ADULT SUPERVISOR. LIFEGUARDS WILL NOT SERVE AS A BABY-SITTERS.**
14. No pets, no running, no playing tag, no horseplay, no diving from sides of pool, and no PROFANITY.
15. Only one person may be on the diving board at a time. Dive straight off the end (Only when diving area is clear).
16. Only one person may be on the slide at a time. Make sure the landing area is clear. No horse-playing allowed on the stairs.
17. **POOL PHONE IS FOR EMERGENCY USE ONLY.**
18. Pool hours are as follows:

Monday through Friday:	12:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.
Saturday & Holidays:	11:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.
Sunday:	1:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.
19. The pool rental fee is \$150.00 FOR MEMBERS and \$200.00 for NON-MEMBERS. Lifeguards are provided by Lakewood Country Club at the rate of \$12.50 per hour. Rental times are Monday through Sunday, 6:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. Members reserve the right to use the pool during the designated times listed above.

- 20. Absolutely NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTAINERS ALLOWED in the pool area.**
- 21. Lakewood Country Club is not responsible for items left at the pool overnight. Please carry ALL personal items home with you each night. Items left unattended for more than 3 days will be discarded.**
- 22. Babysitters are allowed to swim free as long as they are hired by the family to look after their children when the parents are unable to bring them to the pool.**
- 23. No glass containers of any type allowed in the pool area.**
